**Jessica Grisez** introduced the speaker, **Ryan Miller** of 2nd & 7 Foundation. Ryan founded The 2nd & 7 Foundation in 1999 and now serves as the chairman of the board of directors.

From the 2nd & 7 website, this story about Ryan and the organization's founding: When Ryan was a freshman in college at The Ohio State University, he started reading to children through a personal connection with the Boy Scouts of America and OSU athletics. He quickly realized the impact reading can have on young minds and began developing the blueprints for 2nd & 7. After hosting a summer football camp to generate funds to purchase books, Ryan and his former teammates Luke Fickell and Mike Vrabel traveled around Columbus, Ohio reading to seven different second grade classrooms. Soon after, 2nd & 7 was born. As time went on, Ryan became more committed to expanding 2nd & 7. He structured 2nd & 7 around teamwork and began compiling a group of hard working individuals to help promote the importance of reading and encourage student athletes to pay it forward.

Ryan came to Columbus from Allen Park, MI. He played football for The Ohio State University from 1993-1996, where he started at outside linebacker and helped the team capture a victory in the 1997 Rose Bowl. The two-time Iron-Man Award winner was also selected as the co-Defensive Player of the Year as a senior for the Buckeyes. After graduating with an Economics degree, Ryan began a career in sports journalism. In 2005, Ryan earned his Masters degree from the Fisher College of Business (OSU) and founded m2 marketing, LLC. M2 creates websites with a content management system and provides graphic design services.

Ryan described the mission of 2nd and 7: to promote reading by providing free books and positive role models to kids in need while encouraging young athletes of the community to pay it forward.

2nd and 7's reading program encourages studentathletes from universities and high schools across the nation to participate in weekly readings in second-grade classrooms. While in the classrooms, they are reading to the kids, passing out free books for the kids to take home and reminding the kids why it is so important to read. 2nd and 7 has given out nearly 1 million books since its founding.

2nd & 7 created its own book series featuring a group of friends called the Hog Mollies; each book teaches valuable life lessons. In the fall of 2023, 2nd and 7 will distribute its 16th book in that series - The Hog Mollies and the Winter Walk with Wally.

Joining Ryan for further discussion about 2nd & 7 were Executive Director **Amy Hoying** and Senior Program Manager **Janet Kassoff**.
