Angela Lanctot introduced today's speaker **Patty Churan** from Make-A-Wish Central Ohio. Dating back to 1980, Make-A-Wish has granted hundreds of thousands of life-changing wishes to children battling critical illnesses. The foundation is supported by tens of thousands of volunteers, donors and supporters. Make-A-Wish serves every community in the United States and its territories, and a wish is granted every 33 minutes. Since 1993, Make-A-Wish has also served children internationally, and currently has 40 international affiliates in 50 countries spanning 6 continents.

Make-A-Wish does not exclusively serve dying children, in fact, 80% of the children served end up living a relatively long life. The wishes granted these children have a major, major impact on their outlooks as they struggle through devastating circumstances at a young age. Last year, Make-A-Wish granted 5 wishes in the Upper Arlington area. Make-A-Wish needs about \$5 Million more this year to be able to grant all of the wish requests in Ohio, Kentucky, and Indiana.
