Introduced by **Don Ross**, Coach **Jay Moseley** (in his 12th season at OSU) addressed the club regarding the modern state of college athletics and Ohio State golf.

Program Structure:

- Roster is strictly limited to 9 athletes under new NCAA rules (6 from Ohio, 3 international: Czech Republic, Lithuania, Peru).
- Supported by a 3-person core staff and a broader multi-sport "Circle of Care" (dietician, strength coach, athletic trainer, academic advisor).

- Recruiting Philosophy: Focuses heavily on high-character athletes with strong putting/short-game skills, noting that long-game ball striking is easier to develop with modern technology than short-game feel.

- NIL (Name, Image, Likeness) & Revenue Sharing:

- Clarified the distinction between true NIL (third-party brand endorsements/commercials) and institutional Revenue Sharing (direct university payments/contracts capped around \$23M-\$24M per school).

- Emphasized that OSU Golf approaches NIL as an auxiliary opportunity rather than a primary driving motive for joining the program.

- Transfer Portal: Expressed a preference for traditional high school recruiting and four-year player development over heavy portal reliance, though acknowledging grad-transfer opportunities like former OSU standout Neal Shipley.
