Herb Gillen introduced long time friend, Professor Emeritus, and advisor **Herb Asher**. Dr Asher indicated he was happy to be with a "mature audience" as 100 million Americans were not born prior to 9/11. He also believes there is a potential "UA/Bexley Conspiracy" with the number of Upper Arlington Residents seeking State Offices including Vivek Ramaswamy, Amy Acton, Allison Russo, Jon Husted, and John Kulewicz. While he had no explanation, there is a strange irony with candidates residing from just one part of Ohio.

Acher believes Mid-Term Elections could go several ways. They economy is typically the driver and they may be a swing of seats in the US House of Representatives, but probably fewer in the Senate. North Carolina could see a flip. Also, he feels the possibility exists for a 50:50 split.

In Ohio, he felt six months ago the Ramaswamy would have an easy victory, but believes the race is closer today. Topics such as the elimination of property taxes have been tough to define and some may see candidates as out of touch. Difficulty with "issues" usually lead to attack ads to smear opposition.
