Our speaker today was **Kyle Olson**, head boys lacrosse coach at Upper Arlington High School. Kyle is completing his first year as head coach – and expressed his gratitude to outgoing coach Ted Wolford for staying on as assistant coach this season. Kyle confessed that he still gets a kick out of calling Ted his assistant coach since he played for Ted for his four years as a student at UAHS.

Kyle played college lacrosse for two years at Syracuse - where he played on a national championship team – and two years at Ohio State. Before coming to coach at UAHS he coached at Hilliard Davidson High School.

The 2017 Golden Bear boys and girls lacrosse teams are both playing in state semifinal games this week (Wednesday, May 31) in Dayton. The boys team has a 20-2 record prior to the state semifinal. To get to the semifinal game the team had to defeat Dublin Coffman which was one of the two defeats suffered during the regular season. They did just that and will be facing Cincinnati Moeller in the semifinal game. Moeller is the other team that defeated the Golden Bears in the regular season.

The state of lacrosse in Upper Arlington is very positive. This situation is due to a great extent to the Upper Arlington Lacrosse Association (UALA). The association operates an extensive youth program which is an important feeder system into the middle and high school programs. There are currently over 100 children at the earliest kindergarten/elementary levels involved in UALA programs.

We were reminded of the upcoming June 22 “night of Zacapa” hosted by **Steve Sandbo**. New members were strongly encouraged to participate in this excellent networking/social opportunity.

Three Service Above Self Awards were presented at today's meeting. Steve Sandbo introduced the first two award recipients who were instrumental in the effort to acquire two used fire trucks, repair and equip them to be fully operational and ready them for shipment to Guatemala to help the communities we are currently working with. The two trucks (a 1983 and a 1988 model) were available for inspection after today's meeting. The trucks were acquired through the cooperative efforts of a number of Rotary clubs in District 6690.

The Upper Arlington Fleet Maintenance Division and the **Upper Arlington Fire Department** were recognized for their extensive involvement and assistance in getting the trucks ready for their new home. Each was recognized with a Service Above Self Award.

The third Service Above Self Award was presented to **Ted Wolford**, long time head coach – and now assistant coach – for the UAHS boys lacrosse program. **Dave Dewey** cited Ted's extensive resume not only with UAHS lacrosse but also with lacrosse programs in other schools (including the UA middle schools) and around the Midwest. He was named Midwest Coach of the Year in 1993, 1998, 1999, 2004. He was inducted into the Ohio Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 2007. Dave cited Ted's commitment to his players and to the program which brought recognition and honor to the community and provided the student athletes numerous opportunities beyond high school.

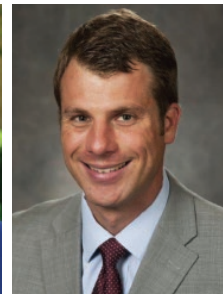
