The West Broad Street/Barrington Elementary Partnership serves 350 students between the two schools. Barrington Fourth Graders are matched to West Broad First Graders as mentors. Second Graders between both schools are paired as peer to peer matches. There are four visits throughout the year -two at each school. The final event is a day at COSI for all students.

This partnership facilitates interaction with kids from different backgrounds. Principal Ifill stated how traveling to Arlington was a new event

for many of their students “have never left the Hilltop.” She hopes that her students see there is a world of opportunity and develop bigger goals. The functions included speakers, science events, math and reading exercises. Barrington Second Grader Julianna DeHays read for the group, and a highlight video of last year’s events was presented.

West Broad Teacher Cindy Leonard told the club her experience as a student at West Broad and now a teacher. She said she wished there was a program like this when she was there. It is a positive experience for all the kids to develop new relationships.

Ted Foster highlighted plans for this year:
