Steve Sandbo introduced the speaker, **Gary Vaughn**. Gary has been married to Janet 50 years. They have two children and four grandchildren.

Gary has worked on water and waste utility matters for more than 25 years and has been an Environmental Consultant for more than 20 years.

Gary has been a Rotarian for more than 30 years. He is a Paul Harris Fellow, as well as a member of the Paul Harris Society. He has been very active in District 6690 and has served 12 District Governors. He has previously served as the Chair of the District's International Service Committee and the Giving Chair.

Gary led a team to Kenya to work with the Rafiki Orphanage and worked on a design and budget that resulting in a bore-hole (water well) for the Orphanage.

While serving 4 years with a Salvation Army medical brigade to Honduras, Gary recognized that most of the illnesses there were water-borne and the doctors were treating the symptom, not the root cause, which was polluted water. He subsequently led two Rotary teams to Honduras addressing water/sanitation issues.

Gary serves as the Foundation Chair for the Short North Rotary Club. He was recognized by the Short North Rotary Club as Rotarian of the year 2006 – 2007 and was again recognized by his club with the Service Above Self award for 2008 – 2009, and was instrumental in the club membership becoming 100% Paul Harris Fellows.

Gary has traveled across the District promoting matching grants and raising awareness of the need for clean water and basic sanitation. He has encouraged clubs to partner together with other Districts on matching grant projects.

Gary has served as presenter at the annual Foundation seminar, the District Assembly and other District functions. He was one of the founding members of the Water and Sanitation Rotarian Action Group. He was awarded the "Citation For Meritorious Service" from The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International, in April 2010.

Gary congratulated our Club for its charitable work and other service, such as the Interact Club and the efforts with Mayan Families in Guatemala. He presented Milt Lustnauer with an award for Milt's service to the Club.

Herb Gillen shared these new funding requests that the Club's board just approved:


- \$250 for busing UA High School students to the Big Table event on Aug. 28.

- \$100,000 over a multi-year commitment for the Upper Arlington School District Legacy campaign. The Club will have naming rights for a room devoted to the research and design program at the High School, which the Interact Club will also use.

Chip Knoop provided an update on the Club's building shed project at Homeless Families Foundation. **Matt McClellan** contributed the design work. Club members' help is needed to build the shed, on each of Sept. 11 and 12, from 3:30 pm to darkness (with a possible extra session on Sat. morning Sept. 14 if needed).

Barri Jones provided an update on the Meals on Wheels deliveries that the Club does as another community service project. The Club handles a route each month, serving 10-12 people. The route takes approximately 3 hours to complete, and is fun to do with a family member or friend.
