Andrew Theado introduced the speaker and UAHS Football Coach, **Jeremey Scally**.

Coach Scally is entering his 15th year of coaching, and his first year as head coach of UAHS. Coach Scally is a 2000 graduate of (Sandusky) Perkins High School where he was a member of the 1999 Div IV (15-0) State Championship Football Team. He graduated from The Ohio State University in 2005 with a degree in English and then earned his Bachelor's Plus degree from Ashland University in Integrated Language Arts. He also holds a Masters degree in Education Leadership from The American College of Education.

Prior to coming to UA, Coach Scally was an assistant football coach at Hilliard Davidson High School. He currently resides in Hilliard with his wife Kasie and daughter Finley. He promises that all blue has been cleared out of his closet, replaced by black and gold.
