Superintendent **Paul Imhoff**, Board of Education Member **Stacey Royer**, and School Treasurer/CFO **Andy Geistfeld** gave an update on the UA Schools Renovation Project. Despite social media rumors, Paul insists this project is “On Time & On Budget.” This was a reiterating theme for the presentation. The district expects student population to increase by 1200 over the next decade.

Phase 1 of the \$230 million rebuilding and renovation for six schools is underway with completion estimates as follows:

- Fall 2020 Wickliffe, Greensview & Tremont
- 2021 UAHS, Barrington, & Windemere
- Fall 2022 Completion of UAHS Site Work

Barrington will have a new building structure replacing pods, and complete refurbishing of the original structure. Barrington will also have a courtyard.

Greensview will have the original building demolished, and then be connected to their last addition.

Tremont will receive a new wing for Kindergarten as well as sports fields that will support the High School.

Wickliffe and Windemere will be the same building, each being built one year apart -saving design money. The two schools will share a campus for a year while construction of the second school is performed. Staggered start times will be implemented to assist with traffic issue.

Upper Arlington High School will have a three-story academic wing. “Gold Bear Corridor” will be the center of the building -50’ wide, three stories tall, and two football fields long. “We didn’t want to rebuild what was put here in the 1950’s with the same thing,” Imhoff explained. Classrooms will have overhead garage doors that will allow rooms to open connectivity for events, or be secluded for smaller class discussion. The new high school will be 400,000’ -over 100,000’ larger than the building it is replacing. The Natatorium will be twice the size of current, with the ability to control access during the day allowing residents the opportunity to use it. Imhoff concluded by informing the club that the Rotary Fitness Center will still be there.
