



**Anne Croskey** introduced founding member and lead singer **Steve Cabot** of Phil Dirt & The Dozers. Steve described his early life as a junior high student that would hang out behind The 21 Club to hear bands play. He developed a love for music and played the guitar and drums. He worked through OSU playing in a band. Phil Dirt and The Dozers was a play on words phrase that he said if “If I had to explain it, you would not understand it anyway.” The group worked local venues and was on TV introducing Friday night movies on Channel 4. On Sunday nights the band would play at The Carousel near 71 and Morse. Steve worked during the day for The State of Ohio for many years, then was out of a favor with a new administration that gave him the opportunity to be a full-time musician. The band is known for their beach themes and leather jacket 50’s sound. Cabot said that he was somewhat intimidated by crowds and began wearing sunglasses to “help with his shyness” on stage.

Phil Dirt and Dozers joined **Jack Hanna** in the creation of the first Zoofari in 1981. They played the Old Ohio Penitentiary in 1985 for Jail House Rock. Steve shared photos and videos from their past and detailed the transitions of different band members. They are currently playing around 100 dates per year, down from a high mark of 183. Most of their shows are in Florida during the winter months. They have played regular annual events including Bay City, Michigan for 35 straight years. During Q & A he candidly said, “Please do not compare us to The Danger Brothers,” as they typically would end their show with a jab at Phil Dirt and The Dozers. He closed by saying this has been a lot of great memories all tied to music.
