

Tracy Kirby introduced today's speaker, Stephen White, VP of External Affairs, Strategic Initiatives and Business Development for COSI. Mr. White is also an adjunct law professor at the Moritz College of Law. Mr. White gave a great presentation on "Servant Leadership," and how the concept has been recently applied through COSI. 1.6 Billion young people worldwide have been adversely affected by COVID-19, particularly with school closings and education. Those who were already behind pre-Covid are now exponentially further behind. It is our job as community leaders to help close the huge divide by serving from our hearts. In response to the pandemic, COSI implemented the 10 components of Servant Leadership by creating educational kits in the areas of Energy, Space, Transportation, Weather, and Water/Climate and distributing them in areas of need, such as foster homes and homeless shelters. Each kit contains 10 hours of content

and 5 hours of activities designed to support minds and bodies and create a love and enthusiasm for learning. Through 400 partnerships, hundreds of thousands of these COSI kits have been distributed across the country and are also being shown globally at the World's Fair. Mr. White also shared one of his favorite quotes which he learned from John Glenn which noted that there is no greater calling than to inspire young people to dedicate themselves to the good of mankind.
