John Krauss announced today's meeting Steve Mollmann with MIS Security. Steve spoke about weapons detection systems, how they work and why they are important. Steve also demonstrated MIS's threat detection platform "Ronin", which can scan 1,000 people per hour and detects not just the presence of a weapon, but where it is located on the person's body. The technology, which implements artificial intelligence, was initially developed by Johns Hopkins and the US military for use in Afghanistan (to detect weapons and bombs). MIS made the technology affordable and expanded its application for use in public areas such as schools, sports venues, churches, night clubs, and train stations. The system doesn't just

detect weapons, it acts as a deterrent. For example, one school shooter indicated he chose a particular school because he knew it did not have a detection system. Over 6 million people have been scanned, and not one weapon has gone through the system undetected. MIS is a philanthropic organization, and provides the system at about 1/3 of its competitors' price with the goal of getting as many schools protected as possible.

Steve answered several questions from members, and then Andy Livingston adjourned the meeting.
