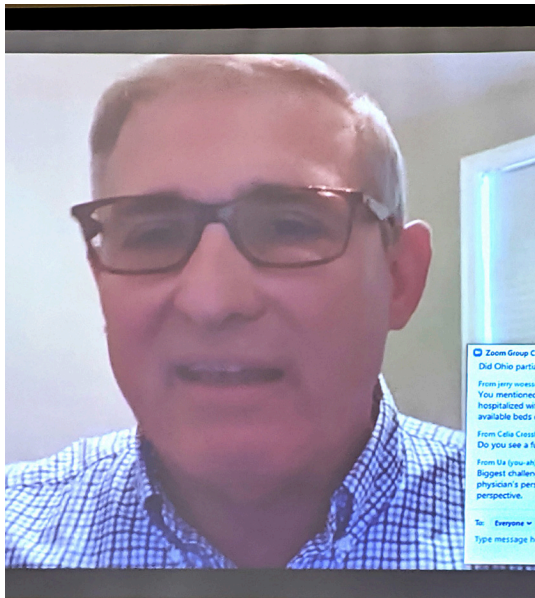

Angela Lanctot gave a live introduction of our virtual speaker, **Dr. Steve Markovich**.

Dr. Markovich is currently the CEO for Ohio Health. He has an undergraduate degree in Engineering at Michigan, but then pursued a Medical degree at OSU after his MBA. Dr. Markovich also has a military background serving three tours in Iraq and Kuwait with the Air Force as a pilot and physician. He has been part of the Ohiohealth network for 27 years.

Dr. Steve Markovich described a new preference for Clinical People in Administration. Understanding the right mission and values is essential to lead and develop hospital organizations. Ohiohealth has 12 hospitals with over 400 affiliated providers in their network around Ohio. Telemedicine obviously has been popular due to Covid-19 and he expects it to remain as a valuable resource. There are advantages for the provider including less staff and facility needs. However, it will not be a complete substitute because doctor and patient physical examination is still essential for most diagnosis.

The response to Covid-19 has created new standards for cleaning as well as the interaction of hospital visitors. Protocols and standards have been modified to maintain safe working environments. Ohiohealth maintain their staff during the

shutdown. Dr. Markovich felt this was essential to prepare for the increased need for services as restrictions are lifted. Qualified staff is difficult to replace if needed quickly, and he expects a surge in Elective procedures that have been postponed.

During Q&A, Dr. Markovich explained how Ohiohealth has added a 5th Value: Inclusion. Their services need to be available to the entire community regardless of employment status, or ability to pay
