Andy Livingston led us through a look back at the '23-'24 UA Rotary year. He offered his thanks to the many folks who make the club tick: The Scioto Country Club staff, **Anne Croskey** (registration and facility scheduling), **Tanya Westerviller** (photos), **Don Trotier** and **Dave Shelby** (setups at Scioto), the Board of Directors, **John Adams** (Treasurer), **Peggy Concilla** (bookkeeping and billing), **Jessica Grisez** and **Angela Lancot** (programs), **Jack** and **Sandra Cotter** (Roundtables), Members of the Rotaryview Committee, **Brad Britton** (UA Rotary Foundation) and **John Trapp** and **Eric Stoll** (membership).

We looked back on the year through a series of multiple choice questions about the club's activities. Andy turned it into a fundraising opportunity by challenging each table to pick the correct answer to a given question. Here are the facts from the '23-'24 year that formed the basis of Andy's challenges:

- New members – 14
- Paul Harris members – 30
- Social Events – 5
- 125 Club Members – 51 (Debbie Johnson thinks this number may have grown to 54)
- Grants awarded – 30 for a total of \$75,500
- Interact Club Activities – 60
- West Broad Elementary Tutors – 11 for a total of 174 hours
- Natun Guatemala Contributors – 42 for a total of \$43,000
- Operation Warm Volunteers – 31 for a total of 70 hours
- Scholarships – 5 totaling \$11,000
- Annual Membership Contributors – 125 for a total of \$45,625

Debbie Johnson summarized the club's Rotary International Foundation participation and thanked the club and those members who contributed to the cause. She noted that **Milt Lustnauer** will be managing the club's RI Foundation program for the '24-'25 year.

Debbie announced that two club members achieved Major Donor status in the past year. She introduced **Chip Knoop** and **Andy Livingston** and presented them with their Major Donor pins. Previous Major Donor members include **Dave Dewey**, **Price** and **Alice Finley**, **Bill Kraft**, **Bob Ness**, **Steve Sandbo** and **Phil Glandon**.

To close the meeting, President Livingston, in his last official act, introduced **Doug Godard** as the UA Rotary Rotarian of the Year. Doug was recognized for his multiple projects to help improve the lives and circumstances of young people in Central Ohio – including Operation Warm which he champions and which provides new winter coats to elementary school students in 8 schools across 4 school districts. West Broad Elementary is one of those schools.
