Milt thanked his wife Bonnie for her support throughout his Rotary service and especially during his presidential year. He honored the incoming club leadership and thanked the membership for their support. A synopsis of the past year's activities and achievements was distributed to members.

District Governor Price Finley presided over the installation of '23-'24 club leadership. Incoming officers and directors were sworn in. Price noted that 46,000 Rotary clubs worldwide were making the same leadership transition in the interest of continuing service.

Andy Livingston was sworn in as UA Rotary's President. The 2023-2024 banner was presented to the club with this year's Rotary International motto - "Create Hope in the World".

Andy expressed his appreciation to the club's committee chairs and the membership as a whole for their commitment to UA Rotary and the principles of service underlying Rotary International. He

asked us to consider the "Power of One" - One club, One committee, One member. When those individual elements come together as one - with common goals - good things happen.

During his term as club President, Andy will focus on five goals.

1.) Expand Paul Harris Fellowship and Club 125 participation.

2.) Individual member involvement in at least three activities during the year.

3.) Each member should introduce at least one person to Rotary and seek their membership.

4.) Fifty (50) percent of new members should be women and a focus on diversity should be maintained.

5.) Each member should get to know another member better at every meeting.

We were reminded that our club "meeting" on July 4 is at the Upper Arlington Civic Association's Independence Day parade. We meet again on July 11 at Scioto Country Club.
