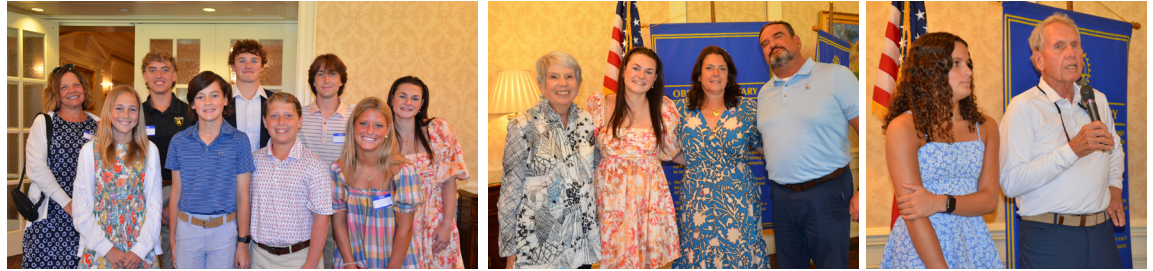

4. Activities may include: preparing pieces for future builds, building furniture, painting furniture, and sorting donations of household goods for families.
5. Parking: Please park inside the fenced lot at the intersection of State St. and Yale Ave. and enter through the door on that side of the building that is labeled "employee entrance". Please do not drive over the sidewalk in the parking lot. Please do arrive more than 10 minutes before your scheduled time. Ask for Galen when you arrive.
