Sandra Cotter introduced today's speaker, retired **Brigadier General Mark Arnold**, who spoke about the Here Right Matters Foundation ([herightmattersfoundation.org](http://herightmattersfoundation.org)), a group dedicated to supporting Ukraine's fight for freedom against Russia. Here Right Matters is led by former U.S. military leaders with decades of service in the U.S. Army, and a record of on-the-ground work in Ukraine to support the country's Armed Forces, civil society, and every day people impacted by the war. The Foundation focuses on three key initiatives: (1) Manufacturing of Drones used for humanitarian and self-defense purposes; (2) Medic Training to help the Ukrainian Medical Academy train 27,000 medics to standards that meet U.S. Medical Corps skill sets; and (3) Child Resiliency to address the adverse physiological and behavioral effects of stress and trauma on the children of Ukraine. General Arnold focused his presentation on the Medic Training initiative.

General Arnold has made several visits directly to the front lines in Ukraine to assist with medic training and operations. He shared some pictures and videos from his visits, showing the extremely challenging and disturbing conditions, not just on the front lines, but in most of the country. Russia has been brutal in its attacks on medical facilities, medics/ambulances, not to mention on the Ukrainian people. So many horrible stories, but the bottom

line, there is a tremendous need for continued humanitarian aid including medical training and supplies. The Foundation is doing tremendous work to directly meet the needs. The Foundation has raised over \$2million for the Medical Education Program, but still needs \$2.4 million to meet its objectives, which have a direct impact on saving countless lives. And there are multiple other programs run by the Foundation that need money. All Rotarians are asked to consider supporting this great organization and cause. Donations can be made through the Columbus Foundation or directly through General Arnold.

General Arnold is doing remarkable work, and is an extreme example of Service Above Self. We should all be inspired by his selflessness and dedication to others.
