#### **ON THE WEB**



UA Chamberlain introduced Joshua Doran, President and CEO of Veteran Companion Animal Services. His organization, "Rescues Dogs to Rescue Veterans." Joshua's background includes joining the US Army in 2008 and serving in Afghanistan in 2011 with the 37th Infantry Brigade Combat Team. When he returned, he felt lost in the transition to civilian life. He was struggling and was admittedly in a dark place. His dog, Scrappy, was lifeline when he needed one. He ultimately graduated from Indiana University.

Doran founded VCAS to enrich the lives of Veterans and Military Families. Veterans are currently committing suicide at a rate of 22 per day. This is far more than casualties of combat. The organization coordinates placement of Rescue Dogs to applicants based on an interview, home visit, and one year placement assistance (pet food and vet care).

Dogs give our Veterans structure and purpose. Applicants are not required to demonstrate any type of diagnosis (PTSD, etc.) to be part of the program. They are required to complete a sevenweek training program and agree to follow-up

The program has transferred into social gatherings for members that includes cook-outs, community events, and family gatherings. They have placed 34 dogs impacting 85 families. Currently, they are placing nearly three dogs each month.

Feedback from their Veterans includes, "I don't have a pet, I have a family member in my apartment." Another commented, "He helps keep things calm."

VCAS is constantly looking for financial support and is a 501c3. They are also having a golf outing on September 10 at Safari Golf Course. More information is available at vcascharity.org or contact Joshua: Joshua.dolan@vcascharity.org Phone: 740 722 3011.

Guests: There were no Guests.






