Tom Westfall introduced Upper Arlington resident and entrepreneur **Rob Littleton**. Rob grew up in UA and received his Undergraduate Degree at OSU. He then studied Systems Biology and Physiology at UC and worked to implement food treatments for cardiovascular disease. He resides in UA with his wife, Susan, and their children that are four and eight.

Rob's project is Littleton's Market that will open in the space previously occupied by Huffman's at Tremont Center. He explained that his goal is to be engrained in the community. Their renovation includes a pavilion that has a grill, fireplace and three-season capability. The market will focus on prepared foods and he explained, "We want to be the best at prepared foods." The renovation includes expanding the previous 9,000 square foot space to over 14,000.

To the approval of many, he announced that he has retained James (from Huffman's) to head their meat shop. The store will have a central island that will be a focal point. Prepared foods and "to go" meals will be available in this area. There will be a chef and experienced staff promote this service. There will also be a cheese and charcuterie station will high quality items. There will be dry goods available, but they will not be in the center of the store.

Littleton explained that he wants his staff to recognize our customers. We will need to walk a fine line between "too high end" and unappreciated. Breakfast sandwiches are one of his favorites, and Littleton's will feature them daily along with a coffee area.

- Planning to open March/April of 2023.
- Currently supporting community with Water Polo and Boys Soccer sponsorship at the high school. Also supporting the Golden Bear Bash and had a hot dog stand on the 4th of July.
- Culinary Classes will be taught for multiple ages.
- Employees estimates are 35-40 and targeted hours are 7AM to 8PM.
- Wine and Beer License only. May have prepared cocktails, but that will be considered in the future.
