Bryan Lane introduced today's speakers **Alexis Ledezma** and **Beth Buehler** with Greater Columbus YoungLives, an organization dedicated to ministering and supporting teen mothers in the Columbus, Ohio area. As a part of Young Life, YoungLives' mission is to introduce teen moms to Jesus Christ and support them.

The teen pregnancy needs in Franklin County are urgent. Teen pregnancy rates are higher than both the Ohio and Nationwide averages. 41.6 per 1,000 mothers giving birth each year are 15-19 years of age. Franklin County also has a relatively high infant birth mortality rate.

To carry out its mission, YoungLives follows the "Five C's": Committee, Contact Work, Club, Campaigners, and Camp. Through the Five C's, teen moms are brought into Young Life where they can deeply share their struggles and challenges, learn more about Jesus Christ and about faith, and participate in a variety of events, including camps. A key mission of YoungLives to help teen moms to stay in school, as education is so critical to build a proper foundation for future success.
